


ASSET BUILDING COMMUNITY DESIGNATION AND SIGNATURE CARE

We have exciting news to share regarding two significant events in the histor y of Cross Connections, Inc.! We are one of 10 local organizations to be recognized by Great KIDS Make Great Communities as an Asset Building Community. The designation is effective immediately through December 2023. Developed by the 2020 Great KIDS Leader Impact Academy cohort, the Asset Building Community (ABC) designation allows youth-serving ministries like Cross Connections to earn a trauma-informed, asset-building designation. The ABC designation is available to organizations in Allen County, Indiana and provides organizations the opportunity to show their commitment to youth development. The designation also encourages organizations to seek education and training for their staff on positive youth development practices based on the Search Institute's 40 Developmental Assets framework. "We are very honored to receive the ABC designation from our friends at Great KIDS Make Great Communities", said Executive Director Matt Konow. "This designation shows our continued commitment to proving hope and healing in Christ for all those who are suffering from recent and past traumas in their lives."
